ALL BREED Classes will abide by Cascade's show rules where applicable. Otherwise, please refer to the rules supplied with the ALL BREED entry form. ALL BREED Classes are also SOAR (Pinto's Open Competition Alternative Program)

ALL BREED Show Entries : Horses shown in ALL BREED classes do not need to be registered with any breed. Please fill out a separate entry form for the ALL BREED classes. ALL BREED Walk-Trot can cross over into the Pinto walk/trot/jog/canter/lope classes.

NEW PtHA Rules Effective 1/1/24 for both Youth & Amateur Walk/Trot that have a current Youth/Am Walk trot card,

are limited to those classes only for the calendar year. He/She may also enter Halter, Yearling in hand, pleasure driving, utility driving, yearling lunge line & 2 year old longe line classes. They may no longer enter any lope classes at any show where PtHA approved classes are held at the same event. If not Walk-trot classes are offered, the exhibitor CANNOT show in any PtHA division with a Canter or Lope.

1. An exhibitor is prohibited from competing in a Lope/Canter class in another recognized equine association including, but not limited to PtHA, APHA, AQHA, NSBA, ApHC, IBHA, PHBA, AHA, AMHA, ABRA, or on an intercollegiate team roster for a lope/canter division, during the same year in which the exhibitor holds an YOUTH OR AMATEUR CARD.

2. Reclassification from Walk/Trot to Amateur and or Novice division can only be requested one time per calendar year.

Please check the PtHA rule book or Online Rulebook.

Exhibitor Eligibility, Showmanship at Halter

Exhibitors may enter any showmanship class available at a show, based on the following eligibility requirements.

a. Novice- requires a current Novice endorsement on the Youth/Amateurs card.

b. W/T- exhibitor is only showing in Youth/Amateur W/T classes for the calendar year.

c. Am/Youth- exhibitor is showing in Youth/Amateur division (horse/mini/pony and is not eligible to compete in any W/T Division.

ATTENTION ALL MINI & PONY OWNERS AS OF 1/1/21 THE HEIGHTS ON MINI AND PONYS HAS CHANGED.

MINIS - MINI A 35 AND UNDER & MINI B 35-39 (ALL MEASUREMENTS WILL HAPPEN AT THE WITHERS).

PONYS - PONY A 39-43, PONY B 43-50, PONY C 50-56

ALL MINI AND PONYS WILL NEED TO BE MEASURED AT THE SHOW NO PERMANENT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED. IF YOUR MINI/PO

OVER IN HEIGHT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW IN AS THE NEW MEASUREMENT AND ALL REGISTERED PTHA PAPERS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE PTHA OFFICE FOR RECLASSIFICATION. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!

Show Office Rules:

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON-LINE AT CASCADEPINTO.COM NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!

ALL ADD/SCRATCH MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE..THE INGATE MUST BE NOTIFIED IF THE ADD/SCRATCH HAPPENS

WITHIN 10 CLASSES BEFORE. NO CHARGE FOR ANY ADD/SCRATCH CLASS IF COMPLETED ON LINE. IF IT WAS A NO SHOW AT THE CLASS YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR THE CLASS, IF THE OFFICE WAS NOT NOTIFIED AT LEAST THREE CLASSES BEFORE THE CLASS.

Show Entries: All horses and riders entered in Pinto pointing classes in this show must be registered with PtHA. All

owners and exhibitors of Pintos being shown must be current members of PtHA. A copy of PtHA registration papers and

current PtHA membership card must accompany entry when sent in. **"No Exceptions"**. Show Management & Show Sec. DO NOT sa

a copy of your horse reg. papers, measurement cards, ptha lease, ptha membership cards.

Per Ptha Office if you can not provide proof of current membership, you will need to purchase a new Ptha membership YA/Am cards

Gate Adds: Class adds at the gate are allowed and no extra charge to add at in-gate please provide your horses name and exhibitors name to the in gate person.

YOU MUST CHECK-IN with the gate person one class prior to the one you have entered.

All Stall & RV Reservations must be paid in FULL ON LINE! No exceptions!!!!

STALLS: FINAL LAYOUT WILL BE POSTED ON FB PAGE BY WED BEFORE THE SHOW. EACH STILL WILL HAVE ONE LOAD OF SHAVINGS PROVIDED IN EACH STALL, EXCEPT THE LOCKED TACK ROOMS WITH FLOORS.

Any dumped water found in a stall after the show that stall owner will be charge 50.00 extra per TU, and a CLEANING FEE OF \$10.00 PER STALL WILL BE CHARGE NO EXCEPTIONS!

Hazardous Material: Syringes and other sharp objects must be disposed of in the proper, clearly marked containers in barns

RV : FINAL LAYOUT WILL BE POSTED ON THE FB PAGE BY WED BEFORE THE SHOW. NOT ALL RV POLES HAVE 30 AMP SERVICE AND SOME POLES ONLY HAVE ONE WATER SUPPLY, PLEASE PLAN AHEAD A BRING LONG EXTENTION CORDS AND HOSES WITH SPLITTERS.

If you need to drop your trailer off prior to the Thursday noon deadline or leave it after Sunday, please make arrangements with the Stall Manager, you will be responsible for paying the extra nights fees.

Patterns: Patterns will be available on-line at www.cascadepinto.com under the show section before the show.

Back Numbers: Numbers are assigned to the horse; the exhibitor must display the correct number when being Judged. All times.

You may purchase a permeant number for \$10 for the year from Casacde Pinto Prior to the show.

Western and English exhibitor numbers must be on each side of the pad.

showmanship, bareback equitation and in hand classes the number must be worn on the exhibitors back.

Driving numbers must be placed on both sides of the cart on the shafts. Halter the number can be on the back or the right hip of the exhibitor. Failure by the exhibitor to wear the correct number in the visible manner while being judged will result indisqualification. See Ptha 2023 Rule book

Refunds: With the new on-line format for all stalls,RV, Entrys. If you are need to cancel your entry to the show, you will be charged a 20.00 service fee. If stalls& RV were pre paid if notified by Monday before the show we will move your stall RV Reservation to the next show. We can not refund anything unless you have a Veterinarians certificate.

No entry fees will be refunded without a Veterinarian's certificate as to the unsoundness of the entered horse.

This must be presented to the Show Secretary before the first class in which the entry is to be shown. Failure to show entry constitutes forfeiture of entry fees. At the show, Management may, at their discretion, waive the necessity of a Veterinarian's certificate. ALL REFUNDS WILL BE MAILED AFTER ALL CHECKS HAVE CLEARED THE BANK AFTER THE SHOW. NO REFUNDS FOR ANY STALLS PRE-PAID AND THEN NOT USED.

Office Hours: The show office will be open late Thursday Evening. Saturday at 6:30 AM and Sunday from 6:30 AM until the last class of the day.

Checks: Personal checks will not be cashed by the Show Office.

Returned Checks: A fee of \$50.00 will be charged on any check returned by the bank for any reason. If full payment plus the \$50.00 return check fee is not paid within 7 business days, Ptha office will be notified and a full suspension from Ptha and all points will be forfeited. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Post Entry: Entry's received after the pre-entry due dates are considered post entry and will be charged a \$35.00 fee.

Office Fee: All entries will be charged \$20.00 for each horse, to help offset the office cost & supplies.

Ptha Horses that are Leased: Must have a approved lease certificate from the Ptha office. NO exceptions

Class incentive fee; Horse Divison 10 class get 2 FREE, Mini/Ponys 7 classes get 1 FREE

Day Stall Fees: 65.00 (for day stall)

RV Fees: 35.00 PER NIGHT IF PAID FOR BY MONDAY BEFORE THE SHOW, 45.00 AFTER THAT DATE.

RV Reservations Can only be reserved by paying on line. If you park in a RV hook-up spot you will be charged a rv hook up fee of 45.00 per night. RV SPOTS ARE ASSIGNED

General Show Rules

Youth walk trot age split: classes can not be combined/but can run concurrently together.

Classes: Every class offered herein will be shown and judged in accordance with PtHA rules. A copy of the rulebook can be found in the show office and with the show manager.

All Exhibitors/Parents/Trainers/Visitors: Must all agree to abide by the Cascade Pinto Horse Association of Washington, Code of Ethics posted in the show office window or on the Cascade Pinto web page.

Exhibitors: Knowing the rules and regulations as well as the requirements for each class entered is your responsibility.

Class Refunds: No refunds for any class that is missed or DQ.

Lunch Break: Lunch will be announced thru the office. The breakouts in the class list are approximate. Please do not ask the in-gate.

Misconduct: Any discourtesy or disobedience to or towards a Judge or any show official on the part of an owner or disqualified entry and all entry fees paid will be forfeited. NO one will approach a Judge with regard to a decision without first obtaining permission from the Show Manager who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge first then will set up a proper time and place. The decision of the judges will be final in all classes.

Combinations/Cancellations: The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split any class which does not fill, has lack of entries or has an excess of entries. Fees will be refunded if class is cancelled by show office.

Mini's and Ponies: All Mini's and Pony's MUST BE measured by an Approved PtHA Representative before you are eligible to show or have a Permanent PtHA measurement card (must be submitted with entry). Please try to have your measurement done as soon as you arrive if they are needed.

Volunteers: Workers you must sign up for a time slot for a position to work at the shows. Remember, 1 hour is required and a meeting to be eligible for year end awards.

Awards: Please check the high point page for all awards and high point divisions.

Cascade Pinto Show Manager makes this disclaimer. The world is not perfect and errors can happen when Hi Points are being calculated. It's the exhibitors responsibility to make sure you check the class list (not just the Hi Point Listing) as mistakes can happen. It's the exhibitors responsibility to check and verify the classes listed for hi point any questions contact the show manager.

All Hi Pt awards need to be picked up by the end of the show, or make arrangements with the show Manager.

High Point Classes: All classes that count for the High Point divisions will be posted on the website and posted in the window of the show office. To Be eligible for a Hi Point you must show in a required number of classes per each division. It will be posted in show office. **We will not ship any awards. Please make arrangements before you leave.**

Individual Class Awards: May & October show will have Average class placing awards, you must sign the book to pick up an award. *Single ribbons 1-6 will be offered for all classes.*

Gate Holds: If a tack or exhibitor change is necessary, the exhibitor may request a two (2) minute gate hold. Request to be made to the in-gate person at least TWO classes prior to break requested. It is ultimately up to the exhibitor to arrive at the in gate on time for their class.

Coaching: During a class coaching which is unsportsmanlike or interferes with other entrants, participants or judges, is prohibited. Management reserves the right to exclude from the show grounds any horse or rider showing objectionable behavior without being held liable for damages or compensation. Management also reserves the right to reject any entry (rider, driver, handler, exhibitor, trainer or coach) it deems advisable in the best interest of the show.

PtHA Walk-Trot: (Youth & Amateur have ROM Points. Per PtHA Rules). All PtHA walk-trot horses must be leased or

owned to be shown. PINTO APPROVED Walk-Trot exhibitors can not cross enter into any Pinto Lope or Canter Class at this pinto show

Novice Youth & Amateur: These are **NON ROM** pointed classes per PtHA Rules. All Novice Youth & Amateur must have a current Novice card & must own or lease a horse/mini/pony to show in PtHA approved classes.

Amateurs: Persons participating in PtHA Amateur classes are those 19 years of age or older who have not engaged in any activities during the past three calendar years which would make them professionals. All exhibitors must present or apply for a current PtHA Amateur and/or Novice Amateur card. Only animals owned or leased by PtHA Amateur are eligible to be shown in the Amateur or Novice Amateur divisions. Leases must be on file with PtHA main office prior to show and proof of Lease from the PtHA Office.

Youth: All PtHA youth exhibitors (18 and under) must present or apply for a current PtHA Youth membership. All Pintos Youth in a PtHA approved show must be Owned or Leased. Leases must be on file with the PtHA main office prior to the show and proof of Lease from the PtHA Office. No Youth can show or handle a Stallion in any Pinto Show Approved Classes.

Stallions: May not be shown in any Youth classes-see PtHA Rulebook. No Youth will be allowed to Handle or Ride stallions outside the show arena or on the show facilities of Tacoma Unit per the Tacoma Unit.

Youth Driving Classes: Are required to have Headers. All Headers must wear proper attire, same as Ideal classes. PtHA rule G8 d.

Ideal Pinto Classes Grooms: GROOMS/HEADERS/ATTENDANTS MUST WEAR PROPER ATTIRE. Proper attire means long sleeve shirt with a collar on the shirt, lab coats or collard smock. Closed toed shoes or boots and long pants are required NO BASEBALL HATS OR CAPS, HOODED SWEATSHIRTS, OR SHORT SLEEVED SHIRTS are allowed. PtHA Rule G8 d.

Halter: Classes will be staged 1 class ahead, hold area will be inside the main arena. NO TROTting OR RUNNING in from the arena gate to the staging area and you must be in the holding area 1 class prior so that we can make sure you get in your proper class and all entries have arrived. We are not responsible if you miss your class (No refunds)

Halter Combinations: If they need to be combined first by type then by age. Miniature A & B if classes need to be combined by size (A&B), We will make ever attempt to post all the halter classes the night before in the show office.

All showmanship, Horsemanship & Equitation class will be lined up prior to the class, you must be present and checked in before your class enters failure to do so and not be ready for your class as it enters, MEANS YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ENTER THE CLASS.

Pattern Classes: In all showmanship, equitation, horsemanship (except walk-trot and all novice) if less than 5 entries have signed up through the show office the show committee will combine with appropriate age group and types.

Protests: A protest must be in writing, signed and addressed to the Show Manager and received by a member of the Show Committee within twelve hours of the alleged violation and accompanied by a deposit payable to PtHA of \$200.00, which may be forfeited if the protest is sustained. Refer to PtHA rulebook for clarification.

Pinto Ranch Horse classes will follow PtHA rules.

Cascade Year End Awards Points: Points from Cascade Pinto Shows will count towards 2024 year totals for all current paid members & sponsors.
